This year, 70 juniors and seniors have enrolled in this two-vear Career & Technical Education program located at All-County Collision & Repair in Homer and Tracey Road Equipment in East Syracuse. Students learn essential skills in the operation and repair



of heavy machinery and heavyduty diesel trucks using the latest techniques and diagnostic equipment. An experienced classroom instructor and on-site professionals are getting them well-prepared for a potential career in this high-demand industry.

## Firefighting and Emergency Medical Technician

This new, two-year Career & Technical Education program is off to a busy start at the Madison County Emergency Management Training Center. Students have the opportunity to earn certifications in Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations (BEFO) and Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)-Basic.



The half-day class combines an on-site classroom with access to facilities, rescue equipment and highly dedicated emergency responders.

#### Career & Technical Education

Students who earn a Career & Technical Education endorsement on their high school diplomas have met rigorous academic and industry standards that are recognized by employers and colleges across the United States.

In 2023, these seniors from Cazenovia were eligible for CTE endorsements: Jon Brown, Avery Dauenhauer, John Fowler, Ernest Franks, Jessie Nourse, and Garrett Rogers.

Joe Awald has found his passion in the Heavy Equipment Repair, Operations & Diesel Technology program housed at Tracey Road Equipment in East Syracuse.

Outside the classroom, Joe is rebuilding a diesel engine in the adjacent shop and sanding and prepping a truck so it can be rebuilt. The work is hard but soothing — the perfect combination for a young man who loves to learn on his feet and work with his hands.

"Joe finds it relaxing to be able to take something that is broken and bring it back to life," said his instructor, Bryan Wilson.

Joe hopes to enter the workforce immediately after high school and land a well-paying job, so the skills he is learning in this two-year Career & Technical Education program will give him an advantage. He also appreciates the friendships he has formed with students from other local school districts, calling it one of the program's biggest benefits.

Every day, he's excited about applying his knowledge — and learning more.

"Joe is always one of the first to be done with his classwork," Wilson said. "He works extremely hard to make sure it's complete so he can spend more time working on projects. This alone shows me that Joe is highly motivated to learn the skills he will need to be successful."
