Heavy Equipment Repair, Operations & Diesel Technology

This year, 70 juniors and seniors have enrolled in this two-year Career & Technical Education program located at All-County Collision & Repair in Homer and Tracey Road Equipment in East Syracuse. Students learn essential skills in the operation and repair of heavy machinery and heavy-duty diesel trucks using the latest techniques and diagnostic equipment. An experienced classroom instructor and on-site professionals are getting them well-prepared for a potential career in this high-demand industry.




Firefighting and Emergency Medical Technician

This new, two-year Career & Technical Education program is off to a busy start at the Madison County Emergency Management Training Center. Students have the opportunity to earn certifications in Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations (BEFO) and Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)-Basic. The half-day class combines an on-site classroom with access to facilities, rescue equipment and highly dedicated emergency responders.



Career & Technical Education

OCM BOCES & Fabius-Pompey = Student Success



Four years ago, as a ninth-grader, Elanor “Ellie” Chick thought she could benefit from a non-traditional approach to learning. She found it at Innovation Tech, which offers a small, focused setting for high school students and an emphasis on Project Based Learning, or PBL.

“It works for me,” said Ellie, who is now a senior. “I find myself understanding material and information better through the PBL process. I also really like the vibe at Innovation Tech — the students and staff are very open-minded, and it offers a community atmosphere where I feel like I fit in.”

With its emphasis on student-driven inquiry, collaboration, class presentations and connections with community partners, PBL has allowed Ellie to explore her individual interests in science and engineering and become a confident public speaker. One of her facilitators, Alex Starr-Baier, said Ellie wants to go to college for biochemistry or biomedical engineering — interests that often require her to explain these topics in a way that a general audience would understand.

Ellie is also getting a leg up on a potential career by participating in the half-day Career & Technical Education (CTE) Laboratory Technician program at the OCM BOCES Thompson Road Campus. The CTE building is just across the street from Innovation Tech.

In both programs, Ellie loves the opportunity OCM BOCES has given her to explore her interests, make new friends from other districts, and feel accepted.

Innovation Tech “has really helped Ellie come out of her shell,” Starr-Baier said. “She feels very supported in our building, allowing her to be the best student she can be.”

Did You Know?

Members of the OCM BOCES Instructional Support Services (ISS) team members conducted a curriculum review in Fabius-Pompey for ELA and are working towards implementing the practices of professional learning communities to improve student achievement this year at the K-6 level. In addition, ISS is also reviewing science K-12 and math at the secondary level to identify key areas of growth.
