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

# SPOTLIGHT: OCM BOCES Embedded Programs

Heavy Equipment Repair, Operations & Diesel Technology

This year, 70 juniors and seniors have enrolled in this two-year Career & Technical Education program located at All-County Collision & Repair in Homer and Tracey Road Equipment in East Syracuse. Students learn essential skills in the operation and repair of heavy machinery and heavy-



duty diesel trucks using the latest techniques and diagnostic equipment. An experienced classroom instructor and on-site professionals are getting them well-prepared for a potential career in this high-demand industry.

### Firefighting and Emergency Medical Technician

This new, two-year Career & Technical Education program is off to a busy start at the Madison County Emergency Management Training Center. Students have the opportunity to earn certifications in Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations (BEFO) and Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)-Basic.



The half-day class combines an on-site classroom with access to facilities, rescue equipment and highly dedicated emergency responders.

#### Career & Technical Education

Students who earn a Career & Technical Education endorsement on their high school diplomas have met rigorous academic and industry standards that are recognized by employers and colleges across the United States.



# OCM BOCES & Jamesville-DeWitt = Student Success



For Jamseville-DeWitt junior Malik Watson, the two-year Laboratory Technology program at OCM BOCES has become the favorite part of his day. He loves the warm, accepting environment that has allowed him to develop strong bonds with his classmates and his instructor, Jennifer Snee. He has become so enamored

with the content of the class — lessons about anatomy, viruses, and tube testing, for example — that his goals for the future are crystallizing.

In class, Malik especially likes gathering in circles with his classmates to share his thoughts and concerns. Circles are part of the Restorative Practices program used at OCM BOCES to help support the social-emotional needs of students and help them build healthy relationships.

"In circles, we can share our feelings and just be honest with each other and get things off our chest, Malik said. "Sometimes, we even gain insights from each other when it comes to certain situations we are dealing with outside of BOCES."

Malik first heard about BOCES from seniors on his cheer team at Jamesville-DeWitt High School. His teammates "talked very highly of it, how what they learned was genuinely fun and exciting," he said.

He also talked to his school counselor and listened to a presentation from OCM BOCES Counselor Melissa Muller. Finally, he shadowed some seniors in the program. Now he looks forward to going to BOCES every day, and his classmates appreciate him. He "puts a smile on everyone's face," said one student, Arden Starowicz. "He always makes sure everyone's voice is heard," said another student, Claud Merkling.

Snee said Malik is a huge asset to the class. During a recent class project on the ethics of animal testing, Malik's "enthusiasm was contagious and truly made this project a success," she said.

Looking ahead, Malik has already set a goal for next year – to attend the OCM BOCES New Vision Medical Professions program. He hopes to someday work in the medical field, with possibilities that range from pediatrics to dermatology.

"It has been wonderful to watch him grow," Snee said. "He is eager to learn, always engaged, and takes the time to understand more difficult topics, which will be a great tool for his future."

### Did You Know?

The Jamesville- DeWitt Central School District is working with OCM BOCES Instructional Technology Specialist Dan Hacker to effectively incorporate technology into their curriculum. Dan has also worked closely with JD administration to roll out the use of ParentSquare districtwide. Other technologies Dan has supported include GoGuardian as a teaching tool, WeVideo for creating infomercials with fourth-grade students, and Promethean boards/panels in the classroom.
