

Over the past two years, this smiling fifth-grader has benefited from small-group instruction, a curriculum that is targeted to his specific needs, and classroom computers that help him stay focused and engaged. His progress has become evident in reading, math, speech and language therapy, and occupational therapy. He is also becoming more confident in his academics and is gradually improving his ability to work independently.

Above all, Hunter treats people with kindness, said his teacher, Amy Whittington, He has developed positive relationships with his classmates and the team of OCM BOCES teachers, teaching assistants,

and related staff who help him throughout the day.

"Hunter is always kind and caring towards others," she said. "He is the first one to help his classmates."

The STAR program at Cincinnatus Elementary School is now in its second year. Hunter and his classmates benefit from the specialized instruction they receive in their BOCES classroom, but they also get opportunities to engage with their non-BOCES peers through lunch, recess, schoolwide activities and "specials" such as art, music and physical education. Hunter, for example, finds great joy in playing with the other students at recess and taking part in physical education.

So far, the STAR program has been a great fit for him.

"He loves the staff, and he loves his friends," Whittington said.

## Did You Know?

The LaFayette Central School District was awarded a \$295,398 grant through the My Brother's Keeper program this past summer.
