Therapeutic Crisis Intervention (TCI) is another way OCM BOCES builds community in its Student Services programs. TCI's goal is to create safe, trauma-sensitive environments by training educators to prevent or descalate crises therapeutically. TCI also provides students with coping tools to handle stressful situations. School districts can receive TCI training through Cornell University in partnership with OCM BOCES.

# OCM BOCES & Cincinnatus = Student Success



As a first-grader, Levi Raymond recognizes all the letters in the alphabet and the sound of each letter. He can also identify shapes and count to 30 on his own. These are just some of the successes Levi has achieved after attending the OCM BOCES STAR program at Cincinnatus Elementary School for a little over a year.

His mother, Marissa, has a much bigger view of what this program has done for him.

"The STAR program has changed Levi's life," she said. "When he was in the general education classroom, he was such a sad and stressed-out kiddo when he would come home from school. Now, he is thriving and progressing in his goals because he is in the proper placement with teachers who meet him where he is. The STAR program was the best thing we ever did for him!"

His teacher, Lynesie Busby-Van Cise, is proud of Levi's progress. When he first entered the program, he struggled to stay physically

calm and focused. The STAR program gave Levi extra time and attention to improve his socialization and academic skills. Levi progressed significantly in those areas and can now participate in "all the center rotations and sit to complete his work," Busby-Van Cise said. "He will even lead the class during morning meetings and tell his peers the days and months of the year."

Levi spends much of his time in the OCM BOCES classroom, but he also has opportunities at Cincinnatus Elementary School to learn and grow with his general education peers. Levi rides the bus, walks the halls and plays with his fellow first graders during recess. He'll soon participate with them in specials - music, art or physical education.

All the educators and staff who work with Levi appreciate his warm, loving and cheerful personality.

"Levi is a very caring and sweet boy," Busby-Van Cise said. "He loves to interact with all peers and staff in the classroom and always asks for a hug or high-five. He also loves to be an entertainer and comedian. He keeps all his peers and staff laughing on a daily basis."

### Did You Know?

Model Schools Teacher Trainer Dan Hacker has been assisting Cincinnatus teachers with instructional technology to help them transition from a traditional teaching model to a "coach approach" that empowers students to take charge of their learning. Working in the district two days per week, Dan has also been helping administrators and educators prepare for the distribution of secure documents in ParentSquare for progress reports and report cards. Recently, Dan has also assisted staff in using Kami, Canva, Magic School AI, and with exploring other AI and virtual reality tools in their classrooms.
