### Building Community

**Restorative Practices:** Poke your head in almost any OCM BOCES classroom, and you'll probably discover a regular "check-in" circle in which students and staff share their feelings, discuss nearly any topic of interest, and ultimately forge close connections with classmates and teachers. OCM BOCES is committed to using circles and other Restorative Practice techniques to support a positive school culture, maintain healthy relationships, and resolve difficulties.



**Therapeutic Crisis Intervention (TCI)** is another way OCM BOCES builds community in its Student Services programs. TCI's goal is to create safe, trauma-sensitive environments by training educators to prevent or de-escalate crises therapeutically. TCI also provides students with coping tools to handle stressful situations. School districts can receive TCI training through Cornell University in partnership with OCM BOCES.

### New! Engineering Technology in Cortland

A new, two-year Engineering Technology Professions program at the OCM BOCES Cortlandville Campus includes exciting partnerships with Cornell University and Tompkins Cortland Community College (TC3). As part of the class, students delve into the fascinating world of nanoscale science at Cornell's NanoScale Facility and earn up to 10 college credits through TC3. This unique opportunity combines hands-on experience with academic rigor, preparing students for college or careers in engineering and technology fields.

## OCM BOCES & Homer = Student Success



Homer senior MacKenzie "Mack" Golden says her three years at Seven Valleys New Tech Academy have been a "fun and fruitful experience," thanks to the opportunity she had through OCM BOCES to learn in a non-traditional classroom setting.

"I signed up to join Seven Valleys because I struggled with larger classes and groups of people," she said. "I came here for a smaller group setting and project-based work."

Seven Valleys embraces a Project-Based Learning (PBL) instructional approach that encourages students to work in teams, take charge of their own learning, and consult with local businesses and organizations on relevant, real-life projects. Through critical thinking, collaboration, problem-solving and communication, students learn the skills they need to succeed after high school.

"I learned to be part of a community, and I benefited from a smaller learning environment," Mack said. "Being in control of my education and the pace at which tasks are presented allowed me to put more effort into my work."

Mack also believes Seven Valleys is a safe and welcoming place for her and other students who come from a wide range of nearby districts.

Her science teacher, Jake Melnyk, says Mack has flourished since she walked through the doors of Seven Valleys her sophomore year.

"She has grown in her abilities in classes and has become a natural leader among her peers," he said. "She regularly advocates for her class and the school at large and has a strong drive and passion for learning."

Melnyk said Mack especially enjoyed working on a women's suffrage project, which included a visit to Seneca Falls. There, students visited historical places related to the Women's Rights Movement.

Seven Valleys Principal Nicole Morgan also had good things to say about Mack.

"On the first day of school, it was obvious to me that Mack was a natural leader," Morgan said. "I have enjoyed getting to know her this year."

The School Library System provides access to a collection of eBooks and audiobooks on the platform Sora. Homer Junior High School has consistently been in the top 10 for the number of checkouts with Sora out of the 143 buildings we serve. Checkouts during the past year have increased 37 percent.
