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

## OCM BOCES & BALDWINSVILLE CSD = STUDENT SUCCESS



Baldwinsville senior Garrett MacDerment is a standout student in the two-year Welding Technology program at the OCM BOCES Thompson Road Campus.

His teacher, Duane Debejian, describes Garrett as a classroom leader who asks questions, collaborates well with others, and approaches every project with care and dedication. He's meticulous about task, Debejian said.

"taking notes and implementing a positive outcome" for each task, Debejian said.

"Garrett tends to ground the class with his patient approach to assignments and work," Debejian said. "He's a model student that any teacher or coach would love to have."

As a sophomore, Garrett was drawn to OCM BOCES but couldn't decide between welding and construction—another two-year Career & Technical Education program at the Thompson Road

Campus. His grandfather, however, was a welder who shared his passion with Garrett. That sealed the decision.

"I decided to do the welding program because of all the knowledge I gained from my grandpa—and wanting to be like him," he said.

Garrett is excited that the program will give him a decisive advantage when it's time to apply for jobs in the trades. He's gaining a wide range of skills, from using oxy/acetylene to cut, to fitting and welding different joints for testing. He'll also have the opportunity to participate in internships before graduation.

Debejian said the door to a successful future for someone like Garrett is "wide open."

Garrett believes the benefits of OCM BOCES extend to everyone.

"I believe that, whether you are looking to go into the trades or simply interested in learning some useful skills, you should 100% check out BOCES," he said.
