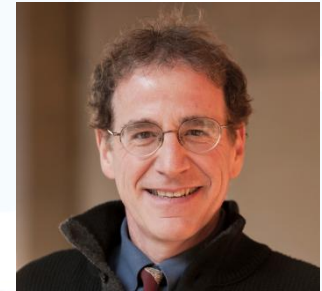
Social Studies Curriculum Work Follow-Up Sessions
