

- The 2024-25 General Fund Budget is \$49,538,835. The District has a full value base of approximately \$897,693,809 with an accompanying true value tax rate of \$19.21/1,000.
- The district employs approximately 405 instructional, non-instructional, and administrative staff.
- In addition to honors courses and a pre-engineering sequence called Project Lead the Way, Homer offers 12 Advanced Placement courses in English, art, biology, calculus, Spanish, U.S. history and other subjects.
- Strong partnerships with several regional colleges allow students to earn college credits in English, agriculature, economics, business, math, science and more.

Homer students excel in Career & Technical Education (CTE) courses offered through the district and OCM BOCES. In 2024, 57 seniors were eligible for an industry-recognized CTE endorsement on their high school diplomas. In addition, 28 Homer students were inducted into the National Technical Honor Society.

- 63.2% of the students in the Class of 2024 went on to higher education in two- or four-year colleges or other post-secondary institutions.
- 38.4% of the students graduating in the Class of 2024 received Advanced Designation Regents Diplomas.
- 51% of students in grades 7-12 participate in interscholastic athletics and other extracurricular activities. High school students can participate in 28 recognized extracurricular activities throughout the school year.
