OUR DISTRICT

The Tully Central School District lies 15 minutes south of Syracuse, N.Y., with convenient access via Interstate 81. Our centrally located campus, which houses both academic buildings, provides easy access for the community.

Residents of Tully benefit from its proximity to a wealth of resources, including several excellent hospitals and healthcare facilities. Higher education opportunities abound, with Syracuse University, SUNY ESF, Le Moyne College, Onondaga Community College,

SUNY Cortland, and Tompkins Cortland Community College all within a short drive. Cultural attractions such as the Everson Museum of Art, the MOST, the Rosamond Gifford Zoo, and the Destiny USA shopping mall are also easily accessible.

For those who enjoy an active lifestyle, Tully's location is ideal. Four ski resorts are within a 20-minute drive, and numerous nearby golf courses, county parks, and public lakes offer ample opportunities for camping, hiking, biking, kayaking, and boating.

OUR SCHOOLS

The Tully Central School District takes pride in being one of the last remaining community school districts in New York State and the focal point of the Tully area. The district boasts numerous unique attributes and accomplishments that distinguish it from other districts in the Central New York region. Highlights include:

- Extensive participation in extra and co-curricular activities nearly all of our students participate in some type of activity such as sports and intramurals, drama club, FFA, student council and the Superintendent's Student Cabinet, band, chorus, or leadership programs such as Daneli Leadership, Teen Institute, and Campus Wide Dialogue, a collaboration with Syracuse City Schools, among a plethora of other activities.
- Significant participation in a number of Onondaga Community College and Tompkins Cortland Community College credit-bearing classes, Advanced Placement classes, as well as Career & Technical Education programs.
- A comprehensive preschool program, an inclusive full-continuum Special Education program, a Maker Lab, and several intramurals are available.
- Unique community programs include the Youth Advisory Committee at the Tully Free Library; the Tully After School Program (TASP), which is housed at the elementary school; the Interact Club, a community service-based club housed at the Masonic Lodge in conjunction with the town Rotary; and the Precision Cut-Ups, a competitive robotics team housed at the Jr.-Sr. High School.

In addition to annual league championships, sectional championships, and numerous state championships achieved over the years, our varsity teams, comprising over 50% of the student body, qualify as scholar-athlete teams each season.
