ELECTRICAL MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

According to U.S. Department of Labor statistics, the employment of electrical maintenance technicians is expected to increase through the year 2020 with the emergence of new technologies that will stimulate the demand for these workers, along with the large number of planned retirements in the field. Our Electrical Maintenance Technician program is an intensive 28-week program of study on electrical maintenance fundamentals that includes five job shadows. Students will receive training in basic shop math, binary math, hand and power tools, precision measuring instruments, electrical blueprints, the 2014 National Electric Code standards and practices, OSHA, electrical theory, conduit bending, introduction to both AC/DC motors, NEMA designations, introduction to digital theory, logic gates, PLC programming, three-phase operation and motor controls, and three-phase variable frequency drives. A four-week work experience is included in the training program.
